- **What is Rebuilding Together San Francisco?**

Rebuilding Together San Francisco, RTSF, a nonprofit organization, preserves and repairs the homes of low-income, elderly, and disabled San Franciscans, and renovates nonprofit community facilities like childcare, youth and senior centers, schools, and homeless shelters so they may better serve their facility users. *

In community facilities volunteers with RTSF work under the direction of architects and designers to make building improvements that help the community agencies function more efficiently, as well as help them to motivate and retain staff, volunteers, and clients. Hundreds of skilled and unskilled volunteers give their time on the last weekend in April to create brighter, warmer, and safer environments.

- **How do I apply for Rebuilding Together SF's services?**

- You will be contacted by a representative from RTSF to evaluate your proposed renovation and perhaps to set up a facility visit between November 2009 and January 2010. The representative will tour your facility with you and discuss possible repairs.
- By early-March 2010, you will receive a letter indicating whether or not your facility has been accepted for the program.
- If your agency is selected for Rebuilding Weekend, we ask that at least one agency representative attends the Facility Orientation Meeting in late March 2010.
- **Rebuilding Weekend 2010: Saturday April 24th and Sunday April 25th.**

**We can provide services to religious facilities only where social services are provided on a non-sectarian basis and on the premises, such as homeless shelters, nutrition programs for low-income residents, etc. If you need further clarification, please call our office.*
